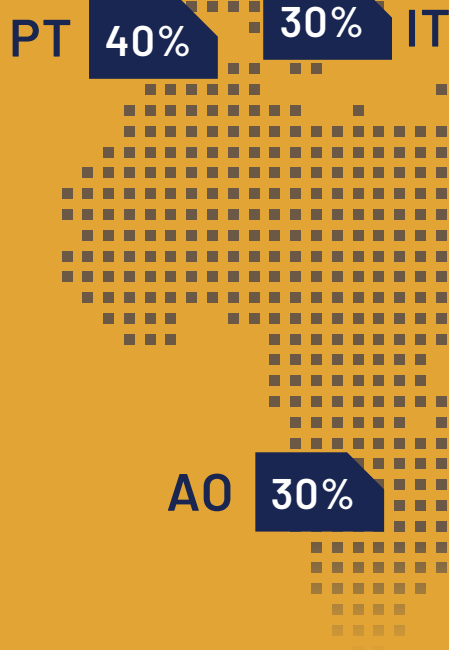

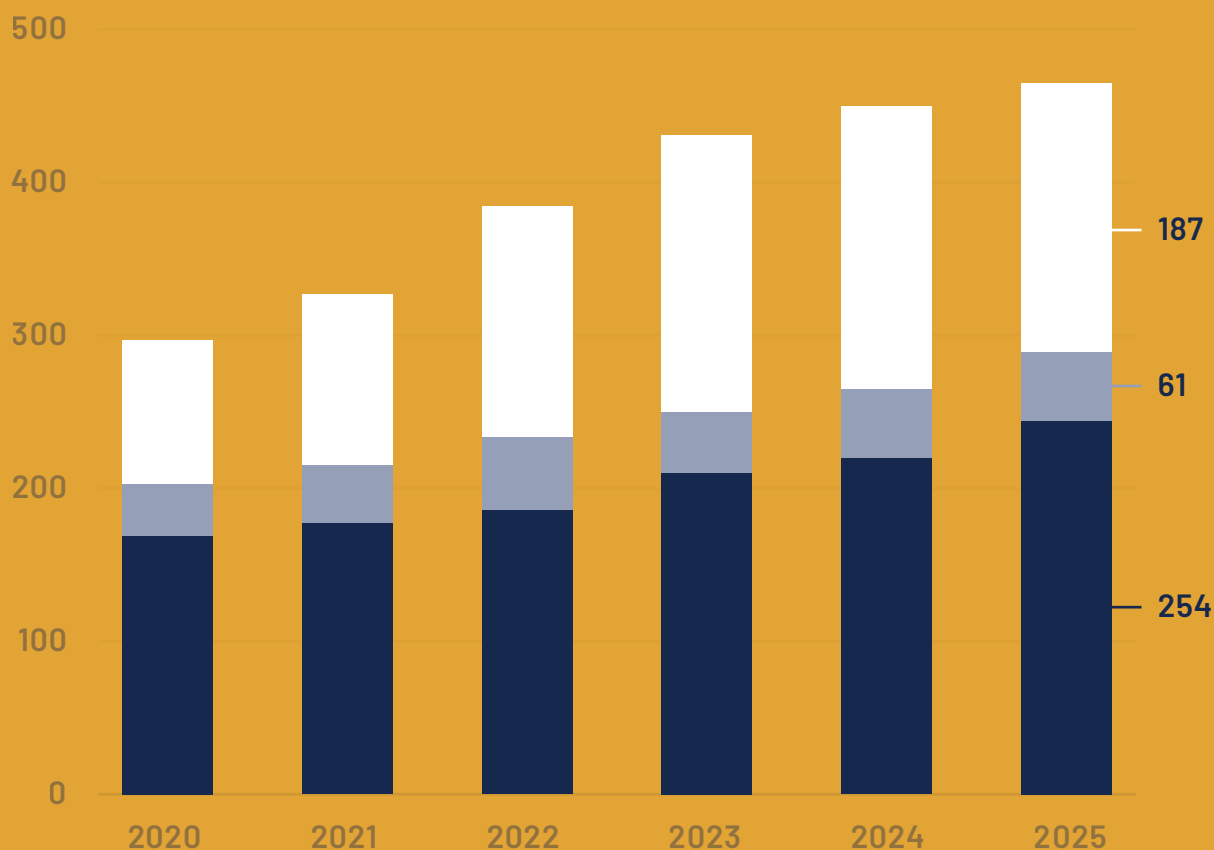
GEOGRAPHICAL REPRESENTATION OF BUSINESS VOLUME

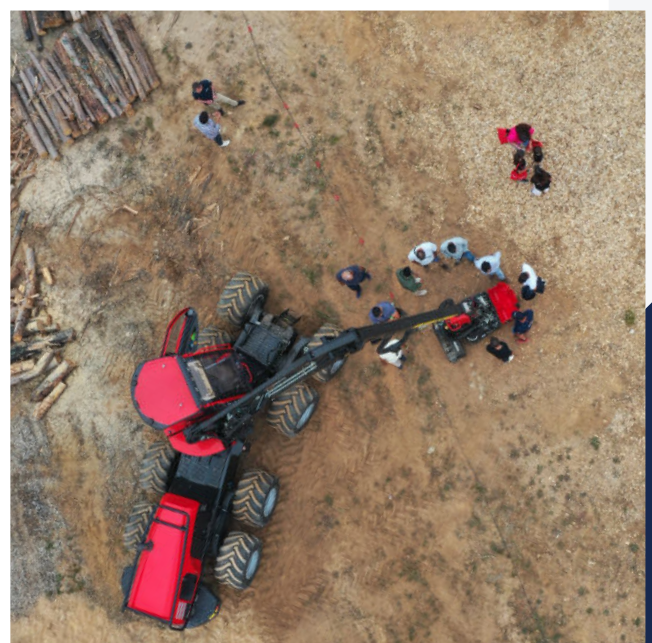

Between February and May 2026, Cimertex conducted four sessions of the Komatsu Crawler Tractor Operator Training as part of the Mais Floresta Programme, an initiative aimed at professionals from the Institute for Nature Conservation and Forests (ICNF) and Intermunicipal Communities.

Throughout the different training sessions, participants had the opportunity to enhance their technical skills in the operation of crawler tractors, essential machines for forest management, fire prevention, and land maintenance activities. The training programme focused on key areas such as safety, operational efficiency, and the adoption

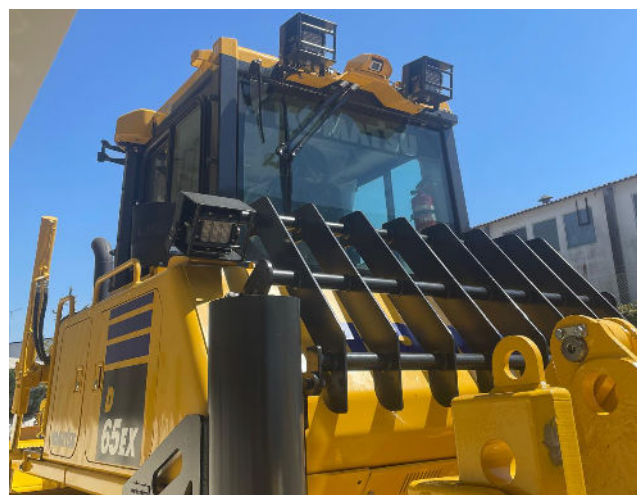
FORESTRY PROTECTION SYSTEMS: TAILORED SOLUTIONS FOR DEMANDING ENVIRONMENTS

Cimertex Indústria has been reinforcing its adaptability through the continuous development of forestry protection systems for various bulldozer models, with particular focus on the D51 and D65. Although this is not the company's core area of activity, it represents a highly customisable range of accessories designed to meet the specific requirements of each operation and customer.

In 2025, the company played a significant role in supplying protection systems for the 18 D65 machines delivered to the Portuguese Institute for Nature Conservation and Forests (ICNF). As part of this project, specific solutions were developed and installed to protect critical components such as the fuel tank, fire extinguishers, filters and headlights, enhancing equipment safety and durability in particularly demanding working environments.

Demand for these solutions has continued to

follow a positive trend. Throughout 2026, orders for forestry protection systems for D51 bulldozers increased. Since the beginning of the year, three units have already been delivered, with a fourth currently in production, a clear indication of the growing recognition and value of these solutions in the market.



CIMERTEX AFRICA DELIVERS 50 KOMATSU HM400 ARTICULATED DUMP TRUCKS FOR MINING OPERATION IN ANGOLA

The Komatsu HM400 is widely recognized for its robustness, performance, and ability to operate in demanding conditions. Designed for the efficient transportation of large volumes of material in mining and heavy construction environments, this articulated dump truck combines high productivity with low operating costs.

Its key specifications include:

- Payload capacity: **40 tonnes**
- Engine power: **353 kW (473 HP)**
- Operating weight: **35,055 kg**
- Body capacity: **24 m³**
- Maximum speed: **56 km/h**
- Dimensions: **11.03 m long, 3.45 m wide, and 3.70 m high**

Equipped with an advanced traction and control system, the HM400 delivers high levels of performance even in the most challenging terrain, ensuring safe, efficient, and continuous operation.

In addition to the quality of the equipment, this project benefits from the ongoing support of Cimertex Angola's after-sales service, providing specialized technical assistance, parts availability, and continuous fleet support throughout its lifecycle.



36 YEARS LATER, A NEW KOMATSU PC55 FOR SIDERURGIA NACIONAL

In 1990, Cimertex delivered its first Komatsu excavator to Siderurgia Nacional. Thirty-six years later, a new Komatsu PC55 has arrived at the company's facilities in Maia to support the daily operations of this industrial site.

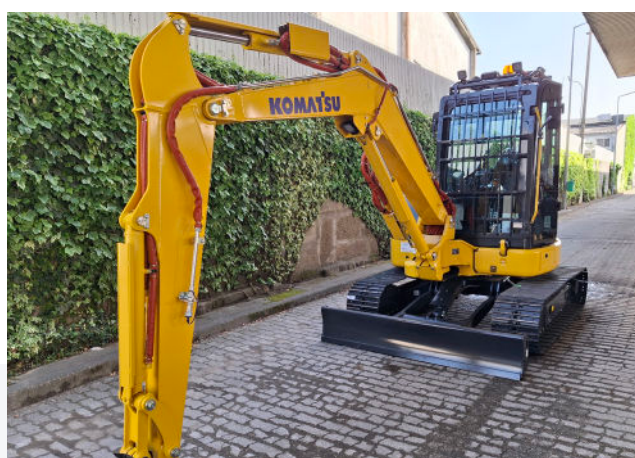
The delivery of this machine marks another chapter in a relationship that spans several decades and reflects the evolution of operational requirements and the technology available to meet the challenges of the industry.

New **Komatsu PC55** delivered in 2026, specially adapted to operate in high-temperature environments.

The new Komatsu PC55 has been specially adapted to operate in a particularly demanding environment, characterised by the high temperatures associated with steelmaking processes. To ensure high levels of reliability and performance, the machine was equipped with specific modifications that allow it to work efficiently under these conditions.

Compact and versatile, the PC55 stands out for its ability to operate in confined spaces, combining power, precision and ease of use. These features make it a suitable solution for material handling and operational support tasks in industrial environments.

The machine's customisation also highlights the importance of adapting equipment to the real working conditions of each operation, ensuring that performance, safety and durability requirements are met even in the most challenging environments.

Thirty-six years after the first delivery, the arrival of a new Komatsu machine at Siderurgia Nacional demonstrates the longevity of these machines and their ability to continue meeting the needs of an industrial sector that is constantly evolving.

FIRST WA485-11E0 IN PORTUGAL MARKS A NEW CHAPTER IN THE PARTNERSHIP WITH JOÃO TOMÉ SARAIVA



Tomé Saraiva, a long-standing partner that once again reinforces its relationship of trust with our organization.

This investment represents the replacement of a Komatsu WA470-5 wheel loader supplied by Cimertex more than 20 years ago. The machine served as the primary loading unit in a quarry operation, demonstrating the robustness and longevity of Komatsu equipment.

The new WA485-11E0 is part of Komatsu's latest generation of large wheel loaders and stands out for its clear improvements in performance, efficiency, and operator comfort. Equipped with a new Stage V engine delivering increased power and torque while optimizing fuel consumption, the machine also incorporates the Komatsu Hydromechanical Transmission (KHMT), which provides high traction, greater efficiency, and improved performance in demanding applications.

Designed for highly demanding environments such as quarries and aggregate production operations, the WA485-11E0 offers high productivity, supported by high-efficiency buckets with capacities exceeding 5 m³ and excellent breakout force. From the operator's perspective, highlights include a completely redesigned cab featuring improved ergonomics, joystick steering, a digital display, and high levels of comfort. The machine also incorporates advanced safety features, including a rear-view camera, object detection systems, and standard LED lighting, contributing to safer and more efficient operation.



Ease of maintenance is another key strength, with simplified access to major components, an automatic lubrication system, and extended service intervals, helping to maximize machine availability and reduce operating costs.

With this delivery, Komatsu further strengthens its presence within the fleet of a key customer, maintaining its position as the preferred solution for a core application within the operation. Cimertex once again thanks the Saraiva family for the trust they have placed in the company.

We are confident that this latest acquisition will be another milestone in a partnership that will continue to deliver value in the years ahead.



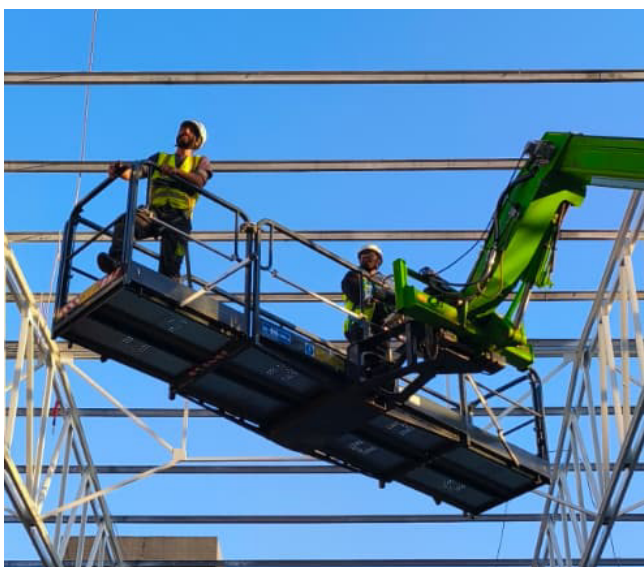
MERLO ROTO 50.21 S PLUS IN THE RENOVATION OF THE GUIMARÃES VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOLS

Among the projects recently completed using Merlo equipment is the renovation of the Guimarães Volunteer Firefighters Municipal Swimming Pools, carried out by EPRent during the first quarter of 2026.

To overcome challenges related to access, working height and manoeuvrability on site, the Merlo ROTO 50.21 S PLUS was selected, a rotating telehandler designed to operate efficiently in demanding and complex environments.

With a lifting height of up to 21 metres, this machine stood out for its versatility, precision and high safety standards, enabling operations in hard-to-reach areas with maximum control and stability.

The combination of these features allowed EPRent to carry out the project efficiently and safely, demonstrating how the right equipment can increase productivity and reduce risks in complex renovation works.



SERVICE VAN MODERNIZATION: GREATER EFFICIENCY AND ORGANIZATION IN AFTER-SALES SERVICE

As part of the continuous improvement of its After-Sales Service, Cimertex has developed a new project to modernize the service vans assigned to field technicians. These vehicles, which have long been equipped with storage systems and tools to support field operations, are now being upgraded with a new configuration designed to meet current operational requirements.

The project involves the complete replacement of the existing storage systems with a more comprehensive and integrated solution, including new storage units, air and electrical hose reels, compressors, and a double-floor system. This configuration creates additional storage capacity, including high-capacity drawers accessible from both the rear and sides of the vehicle, contributing to more efficient use of the available space.

The interior layout has been designed to facilitate access to the equipment and tools used during service operations, through the use of perforated panels for tool mounting,

dedicated areas for specific tools, and properly protected technical compartments. The arrangement of these elements enables faster access to the materials required for field work.

The implementation of this project will take place in phases, in line with the fleet renewal process. Whenever a service van is replaced, the new configuration will be adopted, allowing for a gradual and sustainable modernization of the service vehicle fleet.

One of the project's main objectives is the standardization of service vans, ensuring a common layout for storage systems and equipment across the fleet. This approach makes it easier for technicians to work across different vehicles and contributes to greater operational efficiency.

The new configuration also contributes to a more organized and consistent appearance for the service fleet, reflecting the company's focus on functionality, safety, and service quality.



CIMERTEX ITALIA DEALER MEETING 2026: GROWING TOGETHER

The Cimertex Italia Dealer Meeting 2026 was an important opportunity for discussion and collaboration with the entire dealer network, reaffirming the value of partnership as a key factor in addressing market challenges and seizing new growth opportunities.

The event brought together representatives from the Sales, Service, Rental and Used Equipment departments, with the valuable contribution of Komatsu Finance and Komatsu Italia, who presented tools, services and strategies designed to support the development of the dealer network. The central message of the meeting, "Our Support, Your Success," highlighted Cimertex Italia's commitment to providing dealers with the expertise, services and solutions needed to create tangible value for customers.

Among the key achievements presented were the 2025 market results, including an 8.2% Construction market share (+0.6% vs 2024), and a 4.8% Utility market share, (+1.4% vs 2024). Particularly noteworthy was the Rental

business performance, which recorded a remarkable 77.2% growth compared to the previous year, confirming the effectiveness of the strategies implemented and the strong potential of this segment.

The meeting also provided the opportunity to welcome two new partners who further strengthen the brand's territorial presence: Macchine Edili Repetto for the Liguria region and Sgalla for the Marche region.

Special attention was dedicated to the evolution of the sales approach, with a focus on Total Cost of Ownership (TCO), an increasingly important tool for supporting customers in their investment decisions through a comprehensive assessment of the value generated by equipment throughout its entire lifecycle.

The Dealer Meeting 2026 confirmed the strength of the Cimertex Italia network and the shared determination to continue growing together, leveraging collaboration as a strategic driver for future success.



THE RENTAL MARKET CONTINUES TO GROW AT CIMERTEX ITALY

The significant investments made in recent years by Cimertex Italy in the development of its rental fleet are producing positive results. Rental revenue continues to grow month after month, and projections for 2026 indicate that it will exceed €2.5 million.

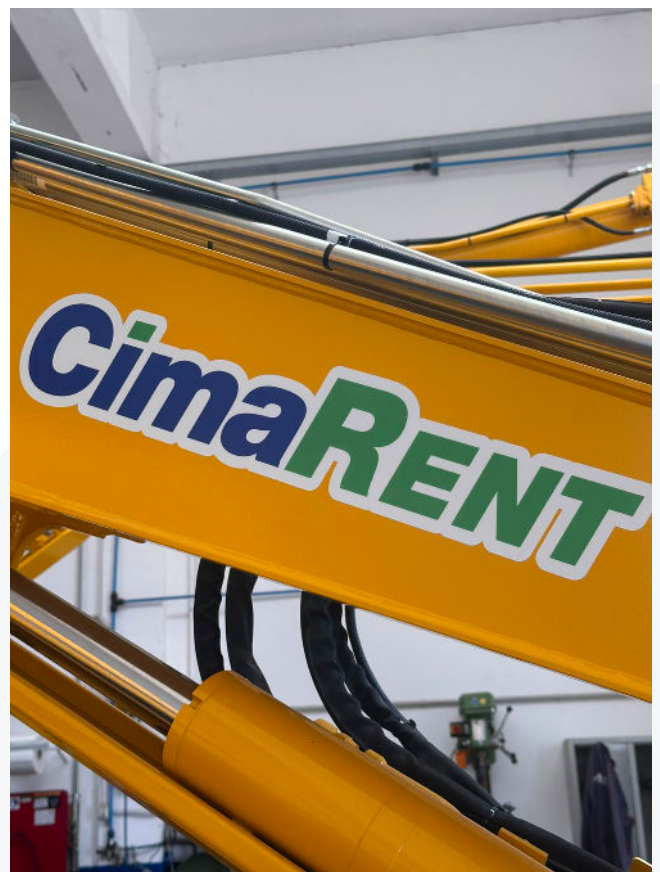
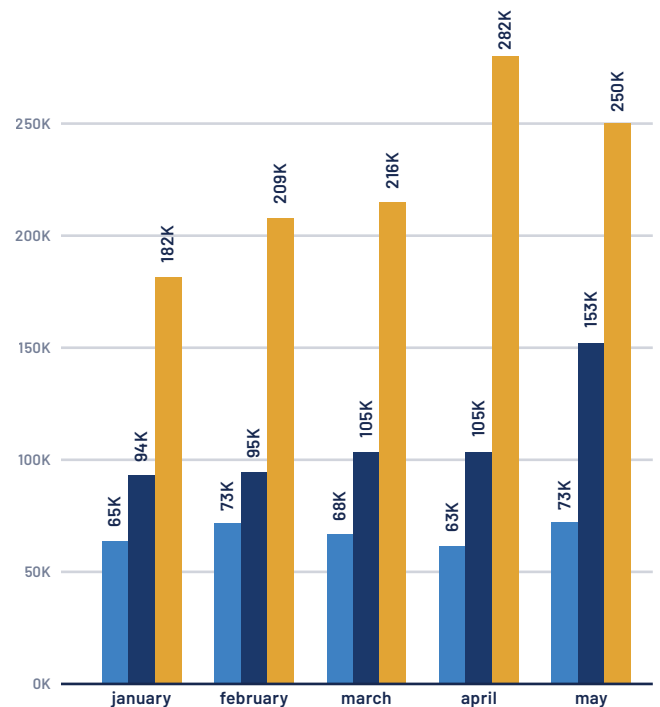
Cimertex Italy's rental fleet consists of 72 machines, primarily for the Construction sector, and has reached a value of €10.9 million. The fleet is also expected to expand further in order to capture the significant opportunities offered by the Italian market.

Today, Cimertex Italy's rental offering includes 21 Construction excavators, 5 dozers, 6 articulated dump trucks, as well as numerous wheel loaders and Utility machines. However, machines alone are not enough: Cimertex Italy's rental offering is complemented by a wide range of hydraulic attachments, including hydraulic breakers, grapples and shears.

The fleet utilization rate is also very strong, reaching 73.3%, providing great confidence in the continued growth of the rental business.

Among the developments planned for 2026 is the introduction of the new Rental logo for Cimertex Italy, bringing together the rental offering of the entire Cimertex Group under a single identity.

2025 RESULTS

- **Waste generated and sent for recycling:** 316 tonnes (-19%)
- **Solar energy:** 35% of Headquarters' energy needs and 48% of Aljustrel's energy needs
- **Training:** 13,926 hours (+12%)
- **Safety inductions:** +82%
- **Lost workdays due to workplace accidents:** -59%
- **Satisfaction with Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) services:** 88%
- **Environmental and safety violations:** 0

More important than the results achieved is the need to look ahead. Sustainability is playing an increasingly strategic role in the way companies plan, invest, and create value.

In this context, Cimertex is consolidating the information and indicators that will support the further development of its Sustainability Report and strengthen the communication of its ESG performance. This work represents an opportunity to increase transparency, monitor the organization's progress, and identify new areas for improvement.

At the same time, priority will continue to be given to energy efficiency, people development, safety, employee well-being, and the strengthening of governance and compliance practices.

Sustainability is a journey of continuous improvement. The results achieved in 2025 provide a solid foundation for future challenges and reinforce Cimertex's commitment to sustainable, responsible growth focused on creating value for all its stakeholders.
